RAF CONINGSBY - LOGISTICS SQUADRON - ANNUAL CHARITY EVENT – 31st ANNUAL BOSTON SLOG CYCLE / RUN RACE – THURS 4 OCT 18

Time zone used throughout the Order: Local.

Situation

1. Staff from Logistics Squadron RAF Coningsby are running the 31st Annual Charity Races to raise funds for Make That Change The Ben Glean Trust, Cancer Research and British Heart Foundation.

Mission

2. To run 4 distinctive physically challenging events that start and end at RAF Coningsby in order to raise funds for the chosen charities.

Execution

3. **Concept of Operations.** The coordination and registration for all events will be through Logistics Squadron personnel currently serving at RAF Coningsby. Although it is preferred to register for the race in advance, registering last minute and the entry fee per person of £10.00 may be paid on the day. For participants not in possession of Military Identification, registration together with photographic identification brought on the day will allow access to RAF Coningsby for this event.

4. **Service Support.**

A a. **Nominal Roll.** Personnel supporting this event on the day are listed at Annex

b. **Responsibilities.** As detailed in Annex A.

c. **Itinerary.** A detailed map of the specified route will be handed to each competitor prior to the event. There will also be a briefing beforehand with a slide show to identify key points on the route so that competitors do not deviate from the specified race route. The 'Iron Man' and 'Iron Lady' and 'Cycle Man' events will commence at 1100 Hrs from Bldg 8 (Logistics Sqn HQ). The return legs will commence as for the other racers at 1300 Hrs from the Boston Stump.

d. **Transport and Travel.** For those participants who are not taking part in the 'Iron Man', 'Iron Lady' or 'Cycle Man' events, transportation will be provided from Bldg 8, T-Bar (Logistics Squadron HQ) to take runners for the 'Fun Run' event at the Boston Stump for 1300 hrs start. This transport will leave RAF Coningsby at approx 1130 hrs. The Cycles from the 'Iron Man' & 'Iron Woman' Events will be brought back to RAF Coningsby on the returning coach and/or support vehicle. All competitors must make their own way to and from RAF Coningsby for this event. Registrations must be completed no later than 1645 hrs.

e. **Accommodation.** Accommodation will not be required by competitors.

f. **Catering.** There are no catering requirements for this event. All competitors should bring with them such refreshments as will be required. Bottles of water will however be provided at various points between RAF Coningsby and Boston for all competitors. Following this event and the presentation of the Trophies, the bar will be open to all competitors and event staff.

g. **Dress.** Suitable running / cycling gear should be worn. Team 'colours' are wholly acceptable. T-Shirts that are torn / damaged or contain offensive motifs are not.

h. **Documentation.** Individuals participating are to be in possession of one of the following:

- 1) Service Identity Card (MOD F90).
- 2) Or valid Passport.
- 3) Or UK Driving License with photo

i. **Medical.** As this event is being hosted by but not sponsored by RAF Coningsby, all competitors must have suitable insurance cover to them for participation in these races. There will however be a *First Responder* on hand to support the event. Their Emergency contact number will be promulgated on the day to all competitors.

j. **Publicity / Station Magazine Article.** SAC Hurst & SAC Lannon are to make arrangements for publicity photographs to be taken and a suitable article submitted for the next Station Magazine publication via the Sqn rep. Assistance from the Station Photographic Section will also be requested to cover all aspects of this event.

5. **Command and Signal.**

a. **Command.** Stn Cdr, RAF Coningsby will retain overall command of all aspects of the 'Boston Slog' Charity event. The OIC on the day will be the Boston Slog Committee Chairman and Event organizer – Cpl Richardson

b. **Communications.** There will be contact details passed to all competitors on the day for the Duty Medical cover, Response Driver and the support elements to the race.
